

Beck Circular Knitting Machines at ITMA Munich Exhibition

A continually expanding company: this is today **Beck Circular Knitting Machines**, a firm operating in the textile machinery sector and building circular knitting machines. The partners of Beck are: Andreas Kirschbickler, owner of the Kitech Packaging & Textil Technology GmbH, Oliver Beck, owner of Oliver Beck Import and Export GmbH, Simone Balconi, owner of Havertex Srl and the Italo-Venezuelan entrepreneur Salvatore Giustolisi. The concern was founded two years ago on the initiative of the technical and sales staffs of a previous business, who decided “not to leave to their fate” the customers they had served up to that time. On the strength of the experience gained in many years of activity, this group of persons set up a new company which today sells its products on the most different markets: in Europe, in North Africa, in the Middle East and in the entire American continent.

At ITMA in Munich, Beck Circular Knitting Machines shall be present on its own exhibition space (**Hall A1 Stand 205**), where it will line up a production bound to “leave a mark” in the circular knitting machine sector. Among the various machines worth mentioning are: the “BSM 2100 Open”, which enables to carry out, with very fine count yarns, operations hitherto unseen in the knitting machine sector.

Further novelties include the “Double-bed Beck Interlock” machine, a technological jewel that further enhances the valuable Beck’s production in this sector.

Finally, a machine not to be missed is also the “High Speed close jersey” model, which for sure will amaze everybody for its very high rotation speed. Innovative and cutting-edge machines in which, according to the company’s tradition, mechanics teams with electronics, computers science and pneumatics: features that have contributed to make Beck machines a real “technology jewel”, that customers can take into consideration at the time of updating their production “assets”.
